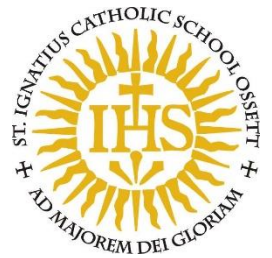




Kid's Corner
