Dear parents and carers,

I hope that this letter finds you all well and enjoying the sunshine!

We are currently planning to extend the number of children that attend school, in line with Government guidance and the announcement made by the Prime Minister. We are putting into place plans for the reintegration of children from Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 from June 8<sup>th</sup> onwards.

We have been working hard with the BKCAT to ensure that we are adhering to all Government guidance in relation to this next planned step. We are currently completing a comprehensive risk assessment to ensure that we are compliant in all aspects of the extended opening and intend to share more details with you over the coming weeks. We await Government Guidance on a daily basis and will keep you informed of updates as they arise.

For your information, School is only open to Critical worker and Vulnerable children week commencing Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June. I am also letting you know in advance that due to staffing limitations, provisional numbers and class sizes being no more than 15 per group, that it will not be possible to cater for all of the year groups from June 8<sup>th</sup>. I must stress that in line with the Government guidance, Vulnerable children and the children of Critical workers must be prioritised over any year group returning.

Primary Schools have also been asked to prioritise Nursery, Reception and Year 1 before Year 6 and therefore school is unable to provide a place for year 6 pupils until at least Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June. I am speaking with the appropriate people to see whether we can arrange additional staffing so that we can cater for our Year 6 pupils as soon as possible. Miss Jackson and I will liaise with you on this matter.

Next week is half term holiday and although school remains open for Critical workers and Vulnerable children, we will not be setting home learning tasks for this week. Enjoy the break, the sunshine and time together.

Thank you for your understanding and patience at this time.
